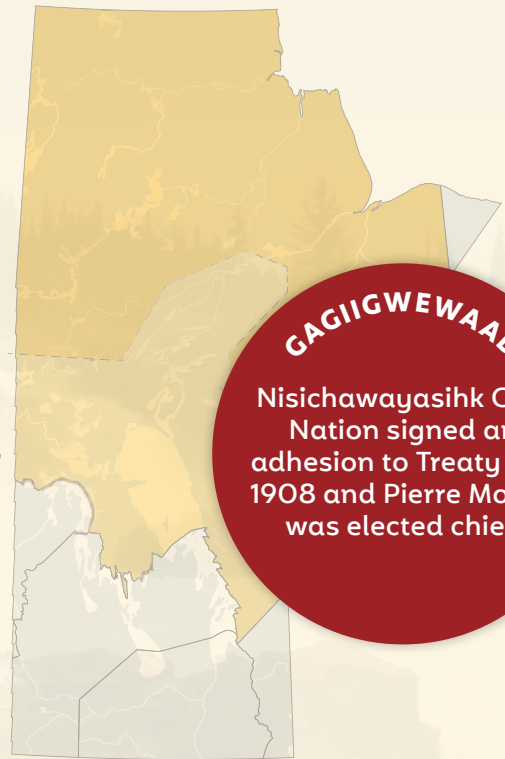

Adhesions to Treaty No. 5 were negotiated in 1908 and signed throughout northern Manitoba during 1908-10. The final boundary for Treaty No. 5 was set in 1910.
