*August 21, 1871*

DAUPHIN RIVER | EBB & FLOW | KEESEKOOWENIN | LAKE MANITOBA | LAKE ST. MARTIN  
LITTLE SASKATCHEWAN | O-CHI-CHAK-KO-SIPI | PINAYMOOTANG | SKOWNAN

Treaty No. 2 was entered into by the under the same terms and conditions as Treaty No. 1. It was signed on behalf of the Anishinaabe by Mekis, Sou-sonce, Ma-sah-kee-yash, François (Broken Fingers), and Richard Woodhouse.
